The seminar focuses on teaching and learning that takes place in museums, and the research paradigms that shape our perception of it. With keynote lectures from Professor Lynn Dierking (USA) and Professor François Mairesse, France, we wish to compare and contrast an Anglo-American perspective with a Continental European perspective. The two speakers have extensive experience in museum education research, and will frame the afternoon's discussions on research paradigms, approaches and traditions. We encourage participants to actively engage during the afternoon workshops and we encourage you to bring your own perspectives to the table.

Lynn Dierking is a Sea Grant Professor of Free-choice Learning at Oregon State University. Her professional focus is on science education with an emphasis on free-choice learning in elementary school and early childhood. Dr. Dierking holds degrees in biology and education.

François Mairesse is a Professor at the Department of Cultural Mediation at Université Sorbonne Nouvelle. His research areas include the economy of culture, the fundamental principles of museology and the history of museums and museology, and collectionism and capitalism. He holds degrees in management and art history.
